The Master of Theology is the highest degree offered by Yellowstone Theological Institute and prepares students for a variety of careers, most notably teaching at a Bible college or similar positions in Christian higher education. It is intended primarily for students who have already earned a Master of Arts or Master of Divinity degree. The program is typically completed in 18 to 24 months.

Incoming Master of Theology students who have already earned a master's degree in Bible or theology will complete a total of 18 hours of seminars and thesis work. Students lacking an adequate background in biblical and theological studies will be required to complete an additional 18 hours of leveling courses for a total of 36 hours.

## FORMAT

**5-day residential intensives either in person or online via live video. Select classes offered as weekly night courses.** All students must attend at least one course in Bozeman each year. Some courses are offered only as residential courses; see course descriptions for details.
