COURSE SCHEDULE & FORMAT

Courses meet for 14 weeks for the designated number of hours each week (*three in most cases*). This will usually be for a single meeting, although some classes may be split into multiple meetings each week (*see semester schedules for details*).

Most courses are taught **in-person at the YTI campus in Bozeman**. For almost all courses offered, **live online attendance** is also available via Zoom (*see course descriptions and semester schedules for exceptions*).

PROGRAM LENGTH: 75–87 hours

A minimum of 75 hours are required to complete the MDiv (87 if taking all biblical languages courses).
